- i) Slough Bus Strategy – Cllrs. Mrs Badcock and Tucker agreed to attend the workshop at the Town Hall on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> November 2005.
- ii) P/11457/002 – Proposed new internal access road and the erection of a new security fence with access gate at Unit 1, Lakeside Industrial Estate – No objections.
- iii) P/12720/002 – Erection of Site Office, Car Wash Facility and Access Gate etc. etc. at ‘The Yard’, Colnbrook by-Pass – Application withdrawn.
- iv) Biffa Application – Sutton Lane – The Chairman supported by other officers referred to recent comments by District Cllr. Howard at a meeting. The Chairman said that Cllr. Howard had spoken in ‘complete ignorance’ of the role played by the Parish Council both in the Grundon’s applications and this one. The Parish Council had instigated, requested and obtained public meetings with the applicants, SBC, the Environment Agency and Parish Councillors. He therefore deprecated and rejected Cllr. Howard’s anti-Parish Council remarks which were both inappropriate and untrue. The Council unanimously supported the Chairman.
