  - (iii) Cllr. Mrs B. Underhill said that she had attended the Westfield Residents Association meeting. She reported that Anne Farmer (SBC) had arranged for a CCTV camera to be placed in a resident's garden to try and catch the persistent fly-tipper in the area.
  - (iv) Cllr. MacDougald said that the next meeting of the Colnbrook Residents Association would take place on 6<sup>th</sup> June at the Village Hall, followed by barbecue on the 10<sup>th</sup> June at a cost of £2.00 per head.
