- c) Letter to Slough Borough Council and the Environment Agency dated 10th August 2007 - OBJECTION to the proposed issue of authorisation on 17th August 2007 to burn more radio-active waste at Colnbrook Plant WITHOUT CONSULTATION with the public or the Parish Council. The Parish Council requires to know why this decision was taken without proper consultation procedures and what safeguards have the Agency put in place?

The Council RESOLVED to raise the issue in the strongest terms at a future Council/Committee meeting and to invite representation from Southampton University to ensure that the full factual implications of this authorisation’s outcome are made known.
